

Worker is sent out to Lebanon

A relief worker from a Bradford-based charity is to fly to Lebanon this week to provide aid to people affected by the current conflict.

A representative from the Human Relief Foundation (HRF) will travel to the country to provide aid.

HRF spokesman Dr Nabeel Al-Ramadhani said: "Of concern for future humanitarian relief operations is the destruction of roads and bridges linking Beirut to southern Lebanon. Shops are not open or open only sporadically and shelves are being emptied as people continue to stock up emergency supplies."

On Saturday, the Reverend Chris Howson, from the Anglican City Centre Mission on Great Horton Road, Bradford, joined forces with the Bradford Stop the War Coalition and the Ash Grove-based Just Church to stage a vigil calling for Israel and Palestine to cease their attacks on each other.
