This work was made possible with the much-needed assistance of sisters NGO's on the ground as well as hundreds of willing volunteers. The main priority for HRF was always to provide relief to the Internally Displaced People (IDP). However recently the authorities allowed the IDP's to return to Swat and therefore HRF's focus has now shifted to long-term rehabilitation programmes for those affected by the crisis.



The total number of beneficiaries to have received assistance from HRF is just under 2500. This has been quite an achievement for HRF considering the conditions and climate were quite difficult to work in.



In the short-term, HRF will base their Pakistan Ramadhan & Qurbani campaigns around the victims of this crisis and in the long-term it is looking to concentrate on rebuilding their livelihoods and everyday life.
